This flowchart provides a step-by-step of how industry can support community-led health responses in each phase identified in the <u>COVID-19 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander</u> Populations Management Plan. Actions also form part of the *Minerals industry remote Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community response framework*.

It should be read in conjunction with the <u>Populations Management Plan</u>, the <u>Remote framework – conditions for easing remote area travel restrictions</u>, local response plans, the <u>National Resources Sector COVID-19 protocols</u>, official health advice and relevant standards or requirements. Community consultation should underpin company responses
