EXPLORE CAREER OPTIONS

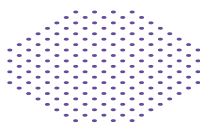
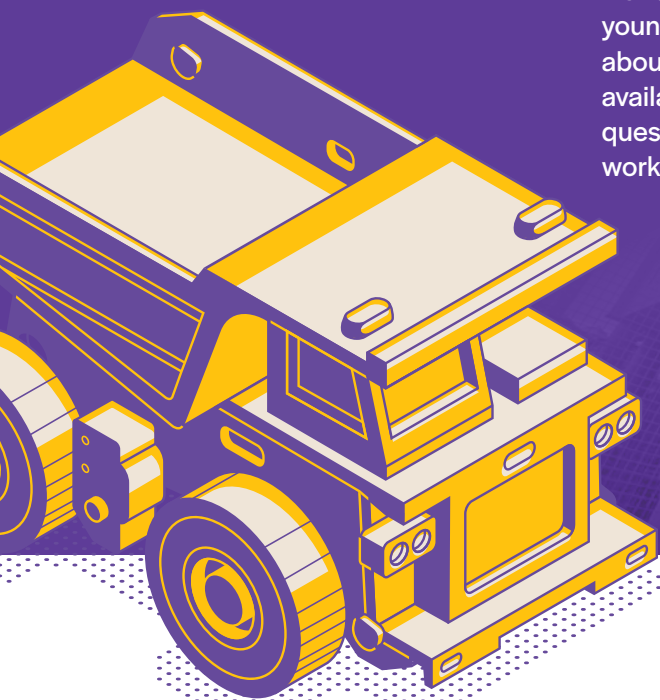
